


INSTALLING THE PLUGIN

Installing and setting up the plugin is very easy and simple.

- Login to your Wordpress admin and
- Click on 'Plugins' in the WordPress Dashboard

- Then you have to activate the Plugin after you finish uploading it.


YES, you need to Click On WP LIST PRO after you come back to the Wordpress Dashboard
